NEW REPORT EVALUATES NEW HAMPSHIRE ROAD & BRIDGE CONDITIONS, TRAFFIC SAFETY & TRANSPORTATION FUNDING

A new report that evaluates the current condition, use and funding of New Hampshire's surface transportation system will be released at a news conference in Concord at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, February 12. The report is being released by [TRIP](http://tripnet.org), a national nonprofit transportation research group based in Washington, DC.

The report, "*New Hampshire Transportation by the Numbers: Meeting the State's Need for Safe and Efficient Mobility*," provides key facts and figures regarding road and bridge conditions, economic development, highway safety, and transportation funding needs in New Hampshire.

Frank Moretti, TRIP's director of research and policy, will present the findings of the report at the news conference. Local officials will be on hand to comment on the report.
