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88 bridges in New Orleans area suffering from significant deterioration



A <u>new report</u> shows 88 state and locally maintained bridges in the New Orleans area are structurally deficient, meaning there is significant deterioration of the bridge's major components.

TRIP, a national non-profit transportation research group, says those 88 bridges equal 12% of the bridges in Jefferson and Orleans parishes. Those structurally deficient bridges carry about 1 million vehicles per day.

The most heavily traveled bridge in Orleans Parish on the list includes the

High Rise Bridge. The report claims more than 116,000 people drive over the bridge every day. The National Bridge Inventory estimated the bridge needed \$52,377,000 in repairs in 2016.

In Jefferson Parish, the most heavily traveled bridge deemed structurally deficient is where I-10 crosses over Veterans Boulevard, according to the TRIP report. The National Bridge Inventory estimated the westbound side of the bridge needs more than \$10 million in repairs, the eastbound side more than \$8 million.

It is important to note, just because these bridges are deemed structurally deficient, doesn't mean they post any immediate safety threat.
