30 BOTTLENECKS IN MARYLAND: A new report released Tuesday [identifies the top 30 traffic bottlenecks in Maryland, including two in Anne Arundel County, and urges](#) state leaders to maintain the recently increased pace of roadway funding, Pat Furgurson of the Annapolis Capital reports. The report by TRIP, a national transportation research group, cited the intersections of the Baltimore-Washington Parkway at Route 175 and I-195 northbound, as two of the worst spots in the state. - Eight points along I-270's 35 miles make the top 30 list. No. 1 is the intersection of I-270 and I-495, the Capital Beltway.
