

Report: Rochester driver loses \$1,700 each year due to road conditions



ROCHESTER, NY (WROC) - The average local driver loses more than \$1,700 a year because of road conditions, according to a new report by the National Transportation Research Group known as "TRIP."

During a news conference Wednesday, TRIP and AAA discussed improvements that could improve local roads and bridges and help eliminate congestion.

"TRIP is an organization that advocates for a transportation system that's well-maintained, is safe and efficient," said Rocky Moretti, TRIP spokesperson. "So obviously those conditions are kept in good condition that the system is running reliably so then your managing traffic congestion and then most critically its as safe as possible."

According to the report, nearly one-third of Rochester area roads are in poor condition.
