



Marc Herbst, director of the Long Island Contractors Association — a construction trade group — said the report should guide elected officials in making policy decisions to address traffic congestion on Long Island. The federal government's last major highway bill, the \$305 billion FAST Act approved in 2015, is set to expire this month.

"The TRIP report on Long Island's traffic congestion quantifies the frustration every Long Islander experiences," Herbst said. "We cannot choke in constant gridlock, or our regional economy will collapse."
