

Worst Massachusetts Highway Congestion in the United States – CBS Boston

Boston (CBS) —New reports show that Massachusetts highway congestion is the worst in the country. [Transport Research Non-Profit TRIP Analysis](#) He also states that state bridges are an area of serious concern.

“In Massachusetts, 68% of cities’ interstate highways are considered peak congestion, the sixth highest share in the United States,” the report said.

According to the report, Bay has some of the busiest interstate highways in the United States, with the eighth highest daily travel rate per lane mile. Only Florida, Delaware, New Jersey, Maryland and California are exacerbating highway congestion, according to the report.

With regard to bridges, the report reveals that 7% of Massachusetts Interstates are rated as “poor / structurally defective.” It only tracks Illinois, Rhode Island, and West Virginia.

A “large-scale construction project” is underway this summer. [Replace 8 Maspik Bridges](#) It’s all over 60 years old.

“As the TRIP report reveals, there is an urgent need to accelerate investment in Massachusetts infrastructure,” said Mary Magwire of AAA Northeast in a statement. “A safe and well-maintained interstate highway system strengthens the U.S. economy, enhances mobility and promotes more efficient movement of goods, but without increasing federal investment in this network. It could be at risk in the future. “

Overall, the report found that most US interstate highway systems require reconstruction, which requires twice as much money as they do today.
