

## Road Conditions in Binghamton Cost the Average Driver One Thousand Dollars a Year

According to a new report from [TRIP](#), the average driver in the Binghamton area loses \$1,180 annually as a result of driving on roads that are deteriorated, congested, and that lack certain safety features.
