

## Report: Albuquerque drivers lose \$3K yearly due to poor roads

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. – Albuquerque drivers lose \$3,061 annually due to deteriorated and congested roads, according to a new report.

The report from [TRIP](#), a transportation research nonprofit, highlights over \$7.5 billion in unfunded transportation projects across New Mexico. This includes more than \$1.1 billion in the Albuquerque area alone.

TRIP’s report, titled “New Mexico Transportation by the Numbers,” examines road conditions, congestion, and safety in urban areas like Albuquerque, Las Cruces, and Santa Fe.
