A proposal to double turnpike tolls for drivers without a New Hampshire E-ZPass moved through its first House hearing Tuesday without opposition. Supporters say the change could generate about \$53 million annually to help close a major gap in the state's long-term highway funding plan.

The bill still faces uncertainty, with Gov. Kelly Ayotte opposed. Lawmakers say the added revenue could help advance stalled projects and prevent deterioration of roads and bridges.
